Could We Contact You In An Emergency?

We appreciate that many people change their mobile phone contracts and get a

new mobile telephone number from time to time. However, if your contact details change (telephone number, email address, home address, etc) please let us know straight away.

This can either be done by emailing our School Business Manager on sbm.haltonlodge@halton.gov.uk or sending us a message with the new details on Studybugs.

If you think we may not have your latest contact details, please send us your updated information.

Punctuality

Although the vast majority of our pupils arrive on time every day, we have a small (but growing) number of pupils who are arriving late for school.

Our school day starts at 08:40 - which is why we open the gates to the school playground at 08:35. This means that if your child arrives after 08:40 they are marked late on the school register. (Should they arrive after 08:55, they are marked as arriving late after the register has closed - and this adversely affects their attendance record too).

As many classes have the same lesson at the start of every day - which is most likely to be a phonics, English or Mathematics lesson - if your child arrives just 5 minutes late each day, this will mean that they miss a significant proportion of a key subject area (and will not make the academic progress they are capable of making).

From the beginning of next week, if your child arrives late you will be asked to complete a Late Slip so we can maintain a record of the reasons for this (and look to resolve any issues as quickly as possible).


