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# Halloween Disco

Mrs Urmson has kindly agreed to run two Halloween Discos – one for the infants and a second for the juniors – next week on Monday

17th October. Both events will also be supervised by members of the teaching staff at school.

With Halloween being the first day back after half term, we have decided to hold these discos before half term, as we imagine that most of our pupils will be up late, trick or treating, when we return to school on Monday 31st October (and then will be looking forward to attending a bonfire or firework display at the end of that week).

If you have a child in the infants, you are invited to come into school at the end of the school day, next Monday, to help them to get changed into their Halloween costume. Once they are ready, they will be able to go into the school hall and you can then take their school clothes and bag home. They can be collected from the school playground at 16:15. (If they are able to get themselves changed, then they can simply bring their costume into school to change into at the end of the school day).

Please be aware: There will be NO after school football club on Monday next week – this will restart after half term. All other clubs, will run as normal next week!

If you have a child in the juniors, they will go home as normal at the end of the school day. They can arrive and enter the school hall – via the hall doors – at 16:30. They must then be collected from the hall doors – by an adult (over 16) – at 17:30.

As this is a school event, we kindly request that all costumes are age appropriate – and do not include characters from 15 or 18 horror films. The cost of the ticket (£2) will include a drink and some treats – so there is no need to send in any extra money. There will be prizes to be won – but nothing to buy!

In order for your child to attend, you must purchase a 'ticket', via School Spider, before 4pm today! This will allow us to buy the correct quantity of drinks, treats and prizes.
